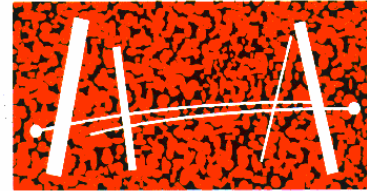

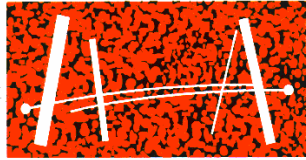

HAMBURGER ARBEITSASSISTENZ

The **Hamburger Arbeitsassistenten gGmbH** was founded in 1992 by the **Landesarbeitsgemeinschaft Eltern für Integration e.V.** in Hamburg (a local association of parents working towards social integration of people with disabilities – itself founded in 1982).

The aim of the **Hamburger Arbeitsassistenten** is to improve vocational integration for people who are at a particular disadvantage on the general labour market due to the type and severity of their disability. These are especially people with learning difficulties and multiple disabilities.

Hamburger Arbeitsassistenten is geared towards the concept of “supported employment” and hence towards vocational integration within companies on the general labour market.

SUDMOBIL – Leonardo-da-Vinci (ESF) transnational project for improving mobility in the vocational training of people with learning difficulties.

bEO – Berufliche Erfahrung und Orientierung [Vocational experience and guidance] – Aktion Mensch (social funder lottery) model project for improving vocational guidance/ prevocational training for school-leavers with learning difficulties.

2005 to 2007



Talente [Talents] EQUAL II (ESF) a transnational model project for improving the options and chances on the labour market for people with learning difficulties, focusing on gender mainstreaming.

Unemployed people

with a disability who are at a special disadvantage on the general labour market due to the type and severity of their disability.

people in sheltered workshops

seeking a career opportunity on the general labour market / supported employment

school-leavers

who due to the nature and severity of their disability are classified as not trainable or employable and require support for the transition to professional life.

and training measures within companies on the regional employment market

during acclimatization and long-term support to stabilize jobs



In recent years **Hamburger Arbeitsassistenten** has particularly extended its services to include vocational guidance and training in preparation for a work placement. This especially affects people with learning difficulties in the transition from school to profession but also people who wish to move from the sheltered workshop to supported employment.
